

44TH CSD BERLIN | BERLIN PRIDE DEMONSTRATION 23.07.2022 from 12 o'clock

On July 23, the 44th CSD Berlin | Berlin Pride will move from Leipziger Straße / corner Spittelmarkt through Mitte to the Bundesrat, then we turn towards Schöneberg and Nollendorfplatz. From there, we move on to the Brandenburg Gate. The total length of the route is 7.4 kilometers. We have registered 500,000 participants with the assembly authorities and the police. This number refers to the whole day.

For the 44th CSD Berlin | Berlin Pride, 96 trucks and vehicles have registered. Look up the complete list of all cars on our website. A new year is when each vehicle and float will have a first aider. We have agreed with this with the authorities. Foot groups did not have to register in advance and could still walk along at any time without registration.

The opening will occur at 11:30 a.m. in the presence of the Governing Mayor, Franziska Giffey. The Berlin CSD e.V. published an extensive list of demands in mid-May. The demands concern, among other things, topics such as violence against LGBTQIA*, HIV/Aids, trans* rights, rainbow families, and standing up for human rights at the World Cup in Qatar. For the second year in a row, the main focus here is on integrating the city's non-German-speaking LGBTQIA* community.

With five association trucks, where over 40 speakers* will speak, we thus aim to increase visibility for the issues and needs of the LGBTQIA* community and show the diversity of our community. These trucks are House of Pride with a focus on Eastern Europe, Mental Health, FLINTA* with a focus on lesbian visibility, POC and Trans, and the Multifaith Truck. Please find the complete list of demands on our website.

For people with disabilities, there will be two podiums along the route again this year. One will be at Potsdamer Platz, the other in front of the stage at the Brandenburg Gate. Admission is without registration on-site upon presentation of the disabled ID. We want to point out that these grandstands are primarily intended for people in wheelchairs or with walking disabilities. In addition, they are limited in the number of seats. Therefore, those who want to get on one of these stands should be there promptly.

This year there is no designated hygiene concept yet. Nevertheless, we would like to ask all members to pay attention to their health and that of others. If legal regulations change until the demonstration, we will announce this on our web page and the appropriate hygiene concept.

We also explicitly point out sexual health and ask to use condoms during sex. On our website, you will find detailed information about the monkeypox/MPX of the LaGeSo Berlin.

In addition, we are already drawing attention to the predicted hot temperatures. Therefore, we ask all participants to protect themselves sufficiently from the sun and to take enough liquid.

Around 4:30 p.m., vehicles and foot groups will reach the final point at the Brandenburg Gate. After that, the grand finale will take place on the main stage with speeches and musical acts. The demonstration will end around midnight. Please find the entire program on our website.

Traditionally, two critical events occur on the eve of CSD Berlin | Berlin Pride. The Dyke March starts at 6pm at Tempelhof Airport / Platz der Luftbrücke and ends at Treptower Park S-Bahn station. First, the multi-religious church service for the CSD begins at 6 p.m. at St. Mary's Church under the guest leadership of the Superintendent of the Protestant Church District Berlin Stadtmitte, Bertold Höcker.

In addition, we refer to any further meetings in the context of the 1st PRIDE MONTH of the citizens of Berlin CSD registered association in co-operation with the culture summer festival Berlin and other partners. The 1st PRIDE MONTH lasts until July 24. Please find the entire program on our website.
